Through Our 3 Missions:

NEST Kids Program

(Community Outreach...now in year 14!)

Weekly programs for children and youth that include faith-based, life-strengthening lessons, meals, and activities

Volunteer leaders, mentors and van transportation

School supplies, clothing and shoes at the beginning of each school year and book distributions scheduled throughout the year to encourage reading at home

Christmas gifts that include clothing and shoes for the children, other essential needs for their families as they arise throughout the year, and birthday celebrations monthly with a present for each child

Extra-curricular costs, camp tuition costs, and support for educational opportunities

NEST Net

(Resources for Children)

A "network" of human, material and financial resources to help with needs that arise for biological, foster and adoptive children

All physical structures used to house items to supply needs
