- * Basic supplies on-site or that can be accessed for children as needed
- * A fenced-in yard and play area with front deck for children to enjoy outside areas
- * Parking space for The NEST Alliance van used for outreach transportation for children and deliveries to families and children
- * Insulated and carpeted storage building for supplies of extra clothing, school supplies, toys, etc.
- * A central place for directors and volunteers to plan, to organize and to assemble requested items for children and families
- * A central location available to DSS case-workers to pick up requested items for a family or child(ren) in need when The NEST Alliance can supply those needs
